

The book is 7 inches by 7 inches, a little smaller than I thought but I never looked at the size either. It's a great book, and I love how it shows where each state is on the map in the right hand corner of

every state. It also has a lot of facts about each state as well. Each State is a two page spread and on the left side it shows the Capital, some facts about the state, a few paragraph's also about the state, and at the bottom it shows the population, when the state joined and what number state it was, the abbreviation, state flower, state bird, and it's nickname. On the right hand side is just a full picture of the state's shape and like I said, there is a pic of where in the USA the state belongs in the top right hand corner. Great fun facts to learn about each state! My 10 yr old son and I really enjoy learning the fun facts each state.
