

Firefighter Jim said to the boys and girls, "I solve problems called emergencies." Of course fighting fires wasn't the only thing firefighters do. In fact, they were soon to learn, they did other things like help people when they got into traffic accidents and rescue "people trapped by floods." Yes, they did all those things, but firefighters responded to medical emergencies the most. Firefighter Jim claimed that "sometimes people who are sick or hurt need help fast." That's because their ambulance could get there before anyone else. Of course they did fight fires and some "firefighters stop wildfires." Maya was very interested in becoming a firefighter when she grew up and Firefighter Jim told her about going to a "fire academy." After his little talk, the children went into the fire house to learn about the tools firefighters use. They learned about an ax, a fire hose, an air pack, bunker gear, how hot a fire
