

If you are planning a trip to a museum this might be an excellent book to share. It would give young children an idea of what to expect. For dino enthusiasts—they'll be introduced to the idea of how these huge fossils are mounted in the museum. They'll see how plaster casts are made of the bones and how iron rods hold them together. This book also shows paleontologists working in the field, and out of all the books in this series, this is the one that has the most information about individual dinosaurs. It's at the 3rd Grade reading level.

My 4 year old loved this book. It's just the right blend of story, science/identification of dinosaurs and has great illustrations. We read it twice in a row.
