

I bought this book for a six year old visitor who has the reading skills of an 8 year old. She was visiting Manhattan and used this book as a guide for herself as we took in the sites. The illustrations are charming and she was able to read the text by herself. Nice guide for the child to read while here in NYC!

We bought this book before taking our preschooler to NYC for the first time. We read it on the plane (long flight) and then decided what sights to focus on. Every night, we'd look through the book again and go over what we'd seen that day and what was on the schedule for the next day. It was a great way to help set expectations for our little one. Some of the choices for the letters are not the most obvious, but it's all well done and works fine.

We bought this book a few months before our 5 y/o son's first trip to NYC - and read it nearly every night! It was so much fun for him to find all the places in the book on our map of the city and in our travels. Highly recommend for kiddoes leading up to a visit - or any time!
