

The story gently gaptures the reader's interest as poor Violet innocently gets into various kinds of mischief. Unfortunately, it is Uncle Leo, who "was never much of a cat person", who keeps getting inconvenienced by Violet's mishaps. I couldn't be more pleased to have discovered this book.
