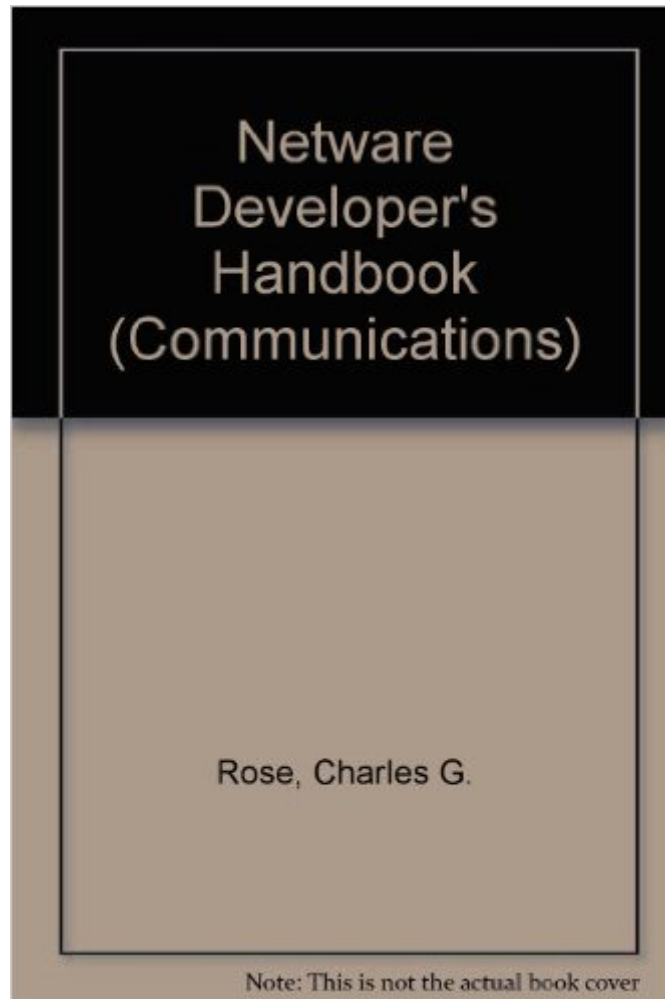


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Programmer's Guide To Netware (Lan Times Book Series/Book And Disk)
