

Bought for my kindergarten classroom, this story is simple for me to read aloud and works as a great introduction to Harriet Tubman. It tends to be difficult to find books that introduce important people for Black History Month, and this is now one of my favorites! Allows for discussion on complex topics for little minds. Would be great to include in a class library for second grade (independent reading levels).

It's a very, very short book; however, I'm grateful to have it as a tool to teach my six year old about

our history. This is a very difficult topic to discuss. I would like a book that explains the underground railroad. The way this book reads, one would think there was a train and a conductor. Ha!

Nice simple kids version of the Harriet Tubman story. My daughter is 3.5 and enjoys this story when I read it to her. It doesn't have a lot of detail though, so for older kids I'd recommend something with a bit more content.

There is slightly more content than my daughter can comprehend right now, but I like the book very much. It spans Harriet's entire life not just her work leading slaves to freedom. I just wish it came in board book format.
