

The brief sections of text combined with the attractive illustrations make for a fun and fascinating journey into the unknown. I appreciated the fact that the author made it clear at several points in the book that there is still a great deal that we, as humans, don't know. Topics covered include: the solar system, planets, the moon, space travel, light, black holes, and more. The book also contains a poster showing northern and southern constellations on one side, with an illustration of the galaxy on the other. I'd highly recommend this book for middle grade readers who love learning about space. I would have liked to see a glossary for the challenging words, but otherwise this is a great book.
